

Costa's McDonald's presents donation

PANAMA CITY — Costa Enterprises, which operates 19 McDonald's locations in Northwest Florida, recently presented a \$1,500 donation to its "Coffee for a Cause" Charity of the Month.

Through Coffee for a Cause, Costa's McDonald's donates 50 percent of all coffee proceeds made at its restaurants every Monday to charity. The November charity was the Fisher House of the Emerald Coast, an organization that provides a "home away from home" for the families of military members undergoing therapy or recovering from a serious medical condition.

In October, the company donated to Making Strides Against Breast Cancer, and in December, proceeds will go toward the non-profit organization Children in Crisis.

In total, seven charities will benefit from Coffee with a Cause. Other charities include the Children's Advocacy Center of the Emerald Coast, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, the Taylor Haugen Foundation and Ronald McDonald House.
